

FROM FR. DANIEL

As the renewal of the Paschal Mystery approaches, the Lord invites today to go deep and consider a twofold mystery. The first aspect is the surprising mercy of God. The wonderful story of the prodigal son, which is the "pearl of the Gospel," reveals the merciful heart of the Father perhaps like no other story. We can see the unconditional love of God, which precedes any merit on our part, which gives everything when we don't deserve anything.

The other side of this mystery is the revelation of our own reality. The prodigal son did not appreciate the Father's love until he came to his senses, until he came to himself. Knowing his emptiness, he was able to know the fullness of his Father's mercy.

This is a Sunday in which we can also recognize those parts of our heart that are empty and far from God, and go the arms of our Good Father, in whose embrace we will be filled to the brim with his joy.



*Tenebrae means shadows or darkness in Latin, and this liturgy, which starts in the darkness of the early morning, emphasizes the darkness that comes over the earth upon Christ's death. With chanted psalms and lamentations, this beautiful and ancient tradition is *a prayerful way to begin your Holy Saturday. It will last about one hour.*
